MESSAGE FROM THE BOARD

Years ago, Jeff Olson had a dream, the dedication, and the vision to create a group of individuals who shared his passion to help feed the hungry here in SD. The dream, South Dakota Sportsmen Against Hunger (SDSAH), was created and continues to grow. If it wasn't for Jeff's dedication and years of work, we could not do what we do today. Thank you Jeff!

Thanks to the interest and effort of many sportsmen/women, a variety of game meat was again donated in the fall of 2017 through SDSAH and was distributed to families in need across the state. The success of this game donation program was also made possible by participating game processors and by public food pantries associated with Feeding South Dakota.



The SDSAH game donation program has expanded over the years and provides a variety of game meat which is greatly appreciated by food pantries to meet the needs of families. Game donated this past year includes 614 deer, 21 antelope, 16 elk, 1,739 pheasants, 1,918 Canada geese, and 152 walleyes. This, plus game meat donated through SDSAH food drives, resulted in 34,015 pounds of game meat delivered to food pantries directly or through Feeding South Dakota food banks for distribution to families in need.

Over 200 hunters took advantage of the SDSAH Processing Certificate Program to pay for processing of donated antierless deer. Also, over 100 hunters used the SDSAH processing certificates available from participating SDSAH processors to pay processing costs of donated Canada geese. Funds used to back the certificates came from nearly 14,000 hunters who made cash donations through the South Dakota Department of Game, Fish and Parks (SDGFP) hunting license application check-off system.

I am ecstatic to be part of and work with the dedicated people on the SDSAH Board, the Feeding South Dakota folks who deliver our donations, and the dedicated professionals at GFP.

We could not be successful in helping 'Feed the Need' without generous donations of money and wild game from you. Hunters are encouraged to continue using the SDGFP application check-off cash donation system and the SDSAH Processing Certificate Program to help us continue. Help us support our communities and their needs.

FISH DONATION PROGAM



Donation of fish by sportsmen and women is but one of several SAH game donation programs which also include not only deer donation as the primary program but also donation of antelope, elk, Canada geese, and pheasant. The variety of donated game meat is very much appreciated by families in need who receive it, as indicated by testimonials from food pantries which distribute the meat. The total amount of game meat donated this past year from all sources was 34,000 pounds which translates into 136,000 meals of meat.

The South Dakota Department of Game, Fish and Parks provides over \$31,000 in in-kind contractual services support for operating SDSAH, and the Department also provides and administers a voluntary Checkoff option on its hunting and fishing license applications whereby hunters and anglers can make voluntary contributions to SDSAH when they purchase licenses.

Donations and Checkoff funds received are spent on processing costs, with minor amounts on other categories as noted in the statement below.
